



Time for Julie

Book Group Questions

Thank you for choosing *Time for Julie* for your book group. I hope you enjoyed reading Julie and

Vincent's story and that these questions serve to bring further discussion to your book group experience.

1. For the person who chose the book: What made you choose this book to read and then discuss in a group? Did it fall short of, meet, or exceed your expectations? What aspects of Julie or Vince's personality stood out to you?
2. What did you think about the women of The Board and their ideas about relationships? What wisdom did you take from them? What ideas did you think were foolish or silly?
3. If there were other books in The Board series (and there will be!)- which member of The Board would you most like to read about? What do you think her story and subsequent romance will be like? What issues or hang-ups will hold her back or help her?

4. Did you relate to Julie's concerns or fears about dating Vince? Was her family reasonable in how they responded to the new man in her life? How might they all have handled things differently (better/ worse)?
5. What aspect of the book, characters, or story did you find to be challenging?
6. Did this remind you of another book or author? Who/ which book(s)/ why?
7. Who were your favorite characters? Why?
8. What characters did you dislike? Were there any characters that you didn't relate to? Why?
9. How did the relationship between Julie and her family cause greater friction between her and Vince?
10. Which character from the book would you like to meet the most and why? What would you like to ask or tell them?
11. What do you think Laura is making in the early parts of the book? Will she ever finish a project? If so, what would make her do that?
12. What about Vince and Julie (or their relationship) did you find to be relatable? Was there anything about them that you didn't relate to or found frustrating?
13. What feelings did this book evoke for you? Why/ how was this accomplished?
14. What was your favorite quote or passage, and why did it stand out to you?
15. If this book were made into a movie, who would you cast? What changes would you want to see happen to work more effectively for film?
16. Does this book remind you of any songs, artist, or other media? If so, which ones/ who and why?
17. Did you think the characters and their problems/decisions/relationships were believable or realistic? If not, why?
18. Did you find any of the characters' decisions to be frustrating? Why?

19. Which character could you relate to the best and why?

20. Did you learn anything new, maybe about yourself or a societal issue that is prevalent today?

21. Make a prediction regarding Vince and Julie's future.

22. What do you predict for Carolyn and Atlas?
